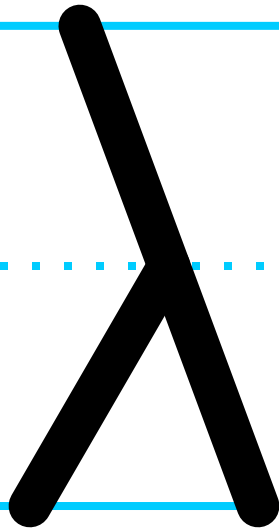
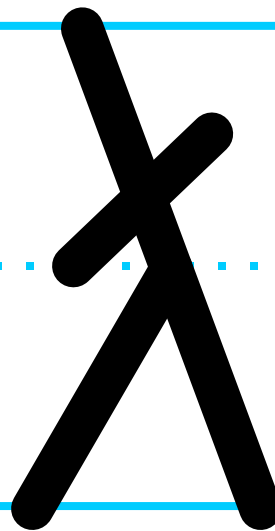

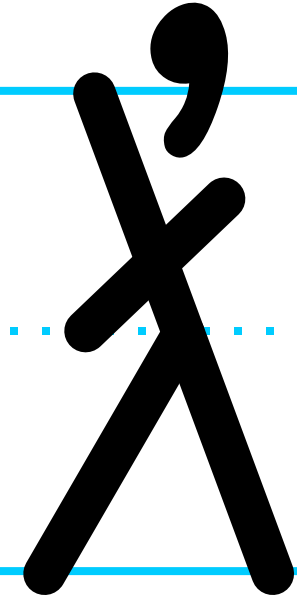
*-upside down

Lambda*



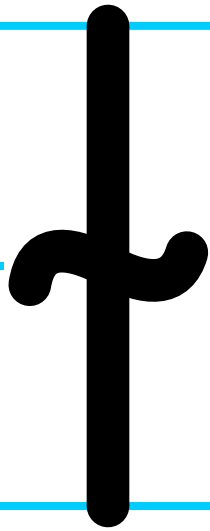
*-bar just over

Tilded L

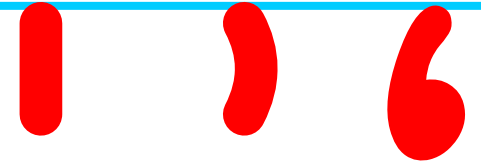


- S-curve about halfway through "l"

Apostrophe




- round head

- no straight lines or dashes
- no slightly curved lines or dashes
- no 6 style apostrophes

á é í ú


- slanted dash

Bars


*Apostrophe,

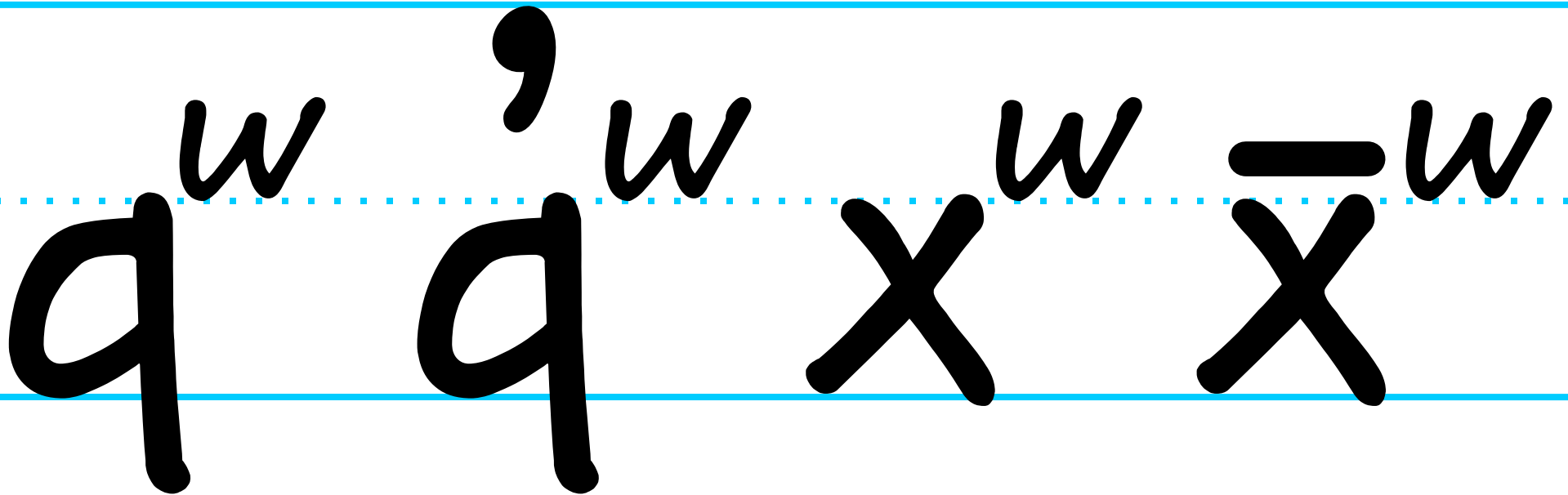
